

**MINUTES OF THE PROPOSED FY27 PROPERTY TAX LEVY
PUBLIC HEARING
ZEARING CITY COUNCIL

MONDAY MARCH 30, 2026**

6:30pm Mayor Beard call the public hearing to order and roll call was taken. Present: Johnson, Pascuzzi, Perisho, Adams. Absent: Hill.

The floor was opened for comments and questions regarding the City of Zearing's FY27 proposed property tax levy. The city is requesting the max levy allowed by the state, as most cities do. It was an increase over last year due to the city having a negative taxable growth. Much of the additional funds will go towards new and increased insurance premiums as well as FICA/IPERS costs because of wage increases. There were only a couple people in attendance besides the council, mayor, and clerk. The only question asked was if the city was requesting the max levy allowed.

6:32pm Perisho motioned to close the public hearing and adjourn, Pascuzzi seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.
