Open Forum: Schlesky – Tree/Water progress, watts – Horse Show, Kennedy – Alley/Tree, Murrell – Open, White-Rose – Great Zearing Days, Schnormeier – No employee raises.

NB: Board of Supervisors ARPA check presentation.

Greg Piklapp – County Updates: Colo with YSS will have child care in Colo and Zearing will also have childcare on Mondays, TIF will be approached with Dorsey & Whitney, Downtown trees – Community Visioning Grnat with \$2K match due September 1st. Development of 2 Housing Projects are possible, Dollar General/Gas Station – discussions are ongoing, Story County ARPA funds will be requested to transition to water projects instead of just engineering fees.

Tany Nunn – Park Board President – Many issues were discussed about the upkeep of the trees that were planted in the South and East parks that were purchased using grants and matching funds. Contact will be made with Luke Gran to see what steps need to be taken to make the best effort to save as many trees as possible. Tree shelter s and netting need to be replaced on the remaining 67 trees and 32 shrubs that remain.

Research will be done with State Center to determine if the council would like to proceed with setting up an ordinance to provide residents with yard meters.

Contact will be made with the City of Colo about CN Rec funding.

Parttime city clerk position was discussed. Possibly look for another person to assist in the office for vacations and days off as needed. Also discuss with Tanya about working extra hours.

OB: Delinquent water bills, 15 letters will be sent this month. Total of the report is \$23,000.00 and the 15 letters are \$10,000.00 worth of delinquencies.

Nuisance Properties – N Elm property is in the City Attorney's hands at this time. 317 N Pearl was discussed and will need to consult attorney about proceeding forward.

Superintendent report – Water tower should be completed before school starts. Water projects continue to move forward despite the discovery of numerous unknowns under the ground at the North Pearl project. There has been the installation of the 8" main with new fire hydrant and 3 water service lines. The West Cleveland project will need to be determined after the North Pearl is completed.

Clerk Report – Been working with the attorney on the alley vacations and nuisances. Working with Greg. Water bill mailing issues have been resolved with Sandy Perisho's help. Water project has had many phone calls and may need to implement a text/calling program for emergencies.

Mayor Report – Pro Tem- Tisdale requested communication from the different departments before purchases.
