Nuisance Properties – N Elm property and N Olive property are being addressed by the City Attorney. Tisdale asked what 2 council members decided arrangements with property owner at 317 N Pearl.

Superintendent report – Sewer tie in is completed at Cheville's property. Concrete work will be completed to fill in the holes from the water main installation. Storm Sewer repair from the corner of Mains to the creek will cost \$29K. Winter maintenance prep has begun. Parks have been winterized. Lead and copper inventory is being collected.

Clerk Report – Council/Mayor Forum will be held Oct. 11<sup>th</sup> from 7pm to 9pm. ARPA funding amendment will be on the BOS agenda for 10/10/23. The computer has been ordered. One item is left to be completed for insurance. Working with new IA Homeland Security person to complete FEMA. Have been working with the Auditors for their additional requests. Part time employee has started. Ordinance for outside yard meters is with the attorney for processing.

Working with Greg Piklapp to amend the Story County ARPA funds. Working on the last 2 insurance items from the August 11, 2022 storm. Communicating with IAHLS to finish FEMA from 2020. Worked with the Library to finally finish the copier contract issues.

Mayor Report – Thank you to Al and Cindy Webb for the purchase of 2 properties and all of the improvements/clean-up that has taken place. Hwy 65 property is an eyesore. Will contact the County again to see what can be done.

Council Reports – Skinner will be working with the DNR to tag fish for the ice derby. Fire Safety will be completed at the elementary school on Oct 11<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>.
